Experiment - D

Colorful Fall Leaves

Activity with an Adult -

This experiment can only be conducted in the Fall of the year just as the leaves are changing color.

A tree needs light to grow. As the amount of light (both quality and quantity) decreases with the fall days, the tree enters a dormant state. This state causes the leaves to die and fall off. For a short period of time each Fall, there is a beautiful show of color on hardwood trees.

Materials:

- 1 sheet of black construction paper
- Several paper clips
- 1 maple leaf (or from any hardwood tree)

Instructions:

- 1. Take the sheet of black construction paper and fold it in half.
- 2. Slide the leaf halfway into the folded piece of paper. The paper should now cover the front and back of ½ the leaf.
- 3. Position paper clips all around the folded piece of paper securing the 2 sides together and holding the leaf in position.
- 4. Leave this for a few days
- 5. Remove the construction paper
- 6. Observe the changes in the leaf

What color is the part of the leaf that was covered? Can you explain what has happened?
